- Incoming students will go by the rules of your institution in terms of minimum and maximum of credits which will be validated; but, they will be evaluated as a regular student in our University through continuous assessment;

 have sufficient proficiency in the Spanish to follow lectures and write academic papers in what is a foreign
 language for them. A free language course is offered at the beginning of each semester, to strengthen their
