Students' application: All students interested in studying at ATENEUM-Szkoła Wyższa w Gdańsku are asked to submit an application form, which can be found on the website: <http://ateneum.edu.pl/students/erasmus-en-gb/>. The following documents must be enclosed and sent by airmail to ATENEUM, together with the printed and signed application form:

- Learning Agreement containing planned course units in our institution. The Learning Agreement may be modified after arrival and discussion with the academic coordinator,
- the Transcripts of Records obtained in previous years of study at home university,
- copy of passport or ID,
- copy of the certificate of completion of secondary school.

The deadline for the winter semester is 31 of August.

For staff mobility: the "Teaching assignment programme" or "working programme" form duly filled in and signed by home university should be sent to ATENEUM.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
