Students' application: All students interested in studying at ATENEUM-Szkoła Wyższa w Gdańsku are asked to submit an application form, which can be found on the website: http://ateneum.edu.pl/students/erasmus-en-gb/. The following documents must be enclosed and sent by airmail to ATENEUM, together with the printed and signed application form:

- Learning Agreement containing planned course units in our institution. The Learning Agreement may be modified after arrival and discussion with the academic coordinator,
- the Transcripts of Records obtained in previous years of study at home university,
- copy of passport or ID,
- copy of the certificate of completion of secondary school.

The deadline for the winter semester is 31 of August.

For staff mobility, the "Teaching assignment programme" or "working programme" form duly filled in and signed by home university should be sent to ATENEUM.

E LAS-PALO1: (SMS) Institutions must nominate their students by an on-line nomination. Instructions will be sent to our partners every year. Students are recommended to arrive one week before the academic calendar in order to attend the welcome week. Students,

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should attend the Faculty in which we have an agreement, having the option of taking courses of other faculties, only if it does not exceed the 40% of the total of courses in the learning agreement.

(STA): The applications must be sent to the coordinator of International Relations of the Faculty in which we have an agreement.

(STT): Every May our Institution organizes an event to receive staff.

This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
